Also present: Jennifer Mays, Erik King and Dennis White. Mayor **McAllister** called for public comments from floor, there were none. MOTION to Accept the 2025 Budget by **Franz**. SECONDED by **Hopkins**. **McAllister** called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried.

All Council members signed the budget certificate. 6:32pm MOTION to adjourn the Hearing to Accept 2024 Regular Budget by **Hoffman** Seconded by **Caywood**. **McAllister** called for a vote. All Ayes. Motion Carried.  
**Adjourned** at 6:32 pm.

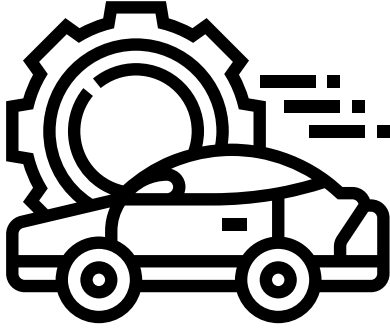
# ♣ Udall 4H ♣
