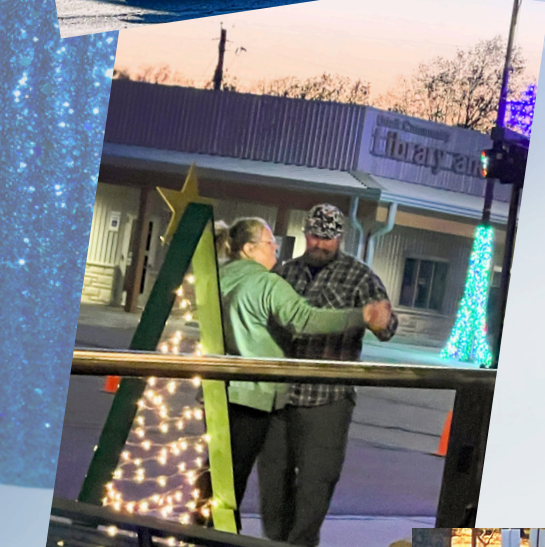

NEW RATES FOR THE CITY OF UDALL

The City of Udall is announcing adjustments to several service fees, most notably impacting trash collection. Effective immediately, residential trash service will increase by \$4.00, while senior citizens will see a \$2.00 increase. Commercial trash collection fees are also rising by \$10.00. In addition, the city is implementing new rates for recycling services, with residential recycling increasing and now - \$8.38 and commercial recycling now- \$22.52. Beyond these specific increases, a standard 2% increase is being applied to all city fees. As an example, a contractor's license, previously \$25.00, will now cost \$25.50, and pet tags are rising from \$5.00 to \$5.10. The City of Udall appreciates your understanding as these adjustments are made.

The Udall City Council met for the City Council Meeting on **Wednesday November 13th, 2024**, at **6:30pm** at the Udall City Hall Council Room. Quorum established. Also, present were Jennifer Mays, Erik King, Dennis White, Kristen McReynolds, Bill McReynolds, and Pastor Jack Wellman.

Meeting brought to order by **McAllister** at 6:30pm

Modification to Agenda – Remove #4 from Police business and Move Library to #1 under new business. MOTION by **Hoffman** to approve Modification of Agenda. SECONDED by **Caywood**. **McAllister** called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried.

3. **KPP Voting Delegate** – MOTION by **Hoffman** to appoint Matt **McAllister** as the voting delegate for the KPP, and Dan **Rutschman** as the secondary voting delegate. SECONDED by **Caywood**. **McAllister** called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried.

4. Dollar General 2025 CMB License approval – MOTION by **Caywood** to approve the 2025 CMB License for Dollar General. SECONDED by **Hoffman**. **McAllister** called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried.

5. **Payroll Increases** – Council will vote on these in December after all employee reviews are completed.

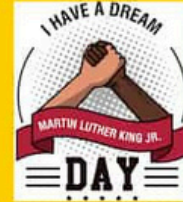

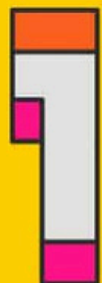

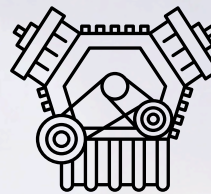
