CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. __695___ (Published in the Winfield Daily Courier on December _19_, 2023 and December _27__, 2023)

A Charter Ordinance exempting the City of Udall, Kansas from the provisions of K.S.A. 12-1651, et. seq., providing substitute and additional provisions which relate to the naming of an official city newspaper, and repealing any ordinance in conflict therewith:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF UDALL, KANSAS as follows:

Section 1. The City of Udall, Kansas, by the power vested in it by Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, hereby elects to exempt itself and make inapplicable to it K.S.A. 12-1651, which applies to this city but does not apply uniformly to all cities.

Section 2. The governing body shall designate by authorizing, upon proper resolution, the Udall City website, https://cityofudall.com/ as the official city newspaper.

Section 3. This charter ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

Section 4. This charter ordinance shall take effect 61 days after the final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed, requiring a referendum to be held on the ordinance as provided by Article 12, Section 5, Subsection (c)(3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case this charter ordinance shall become effective upon approval by the majority of the electors voting thereon.

Passed by the governing body, not less than two-thirds of the members-elect voting in favor thereof, this 13th day of December, 2023.
