

## ORDINANCE NO. 699

### AN ORDINANCE

An Ordinance adopting a general sales tax of one percent (1%) on all retail sales within the City limits of the City of Udall, Kansas

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF UDALL, KANSAS, THAT:

**Section 1.** During a general election held November 5, 2024, the voters of Udall, Kansas, passed a question allowing the governing body of the City to impose a one percent (1%) sales tax starting September 30, 2025 and extending to September 30, 2035 for the purpose of defraying the costs of Phase II and Phase III Water Projects for the City of Udall, Kansas. Said question had 200 yes votes and 85 no votes.

**Section 2.** As a result of the November 5, 2024, general election vote, there will be imposed on all retail sales within the city limits of the City of Udall, Kansas, a one percent (1%) sales tax.

**Section 3.** The sales tax imposed herein shall be used for the purpose of defraying the costs of Phase II and Phase III Water Projects for the City of Udall, Kansas.

**Section 4.** The sales tax imposed herein shall be effective starting September 30, 2025, and extending to September 30, 2035, when it shall end, unless extended, at that time by vote at general or special election.

**Section 5.** Revenue from the imposed sales tax shall be deposited in the appropriate City account until approval for its disbursement is made by the City Council.


**Section 6.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in the official city newspaper.
